##### MICROCHIPPING DAY 25TH FEBRUARY 2012

A dog and cat microchipping day will take place at the Mansfield Shire Offices from 10am to 2pm on Saturday 25th February. This event will provide dog and cat owners the opportunity to have their pet micro chipped at the discounted rate of \$30.00. A microchip is a permanent form of identification and can greatly improve the return of lost and stolen pets to their owners.

It is a statutory requirement for all cats and dogs over 3 months of age to be registered with council. It is also a requirement for pet owners to provide Council with the animal's microchip number for all new registrations, and for any animals being re-registered following a lapse in their registration. It is also a mandatory requirement for any advertisement offering a pet for sale to include the animal's unique microchip number.

- Cats must be secured in a cage
