8.1. Lakins Road Land Sale

Confidential

8.2. Variation Mt Battery Road - HVAR Stage 2 Construction

Councillor Paul Sladdin/Councillor Rohan Webb:

THAT COUNCIL:

- 1. Approves a contract variation to the HVAR Stage 2 contract with North East Civil Construction in the amount of \$357,549.70 (ex GST) for the revised intersection, stormwater and footpath components on Mt Battery Road.
- 2. Notes the allocation of existing project contingency funds of \$16,305.70 towards the contract variation amount.
- 3. Notes that the Proposed 2023/24 Budget will include an amount of \$932,837 (ex GST) for completion of the HVAR Stage 2 Construction.
- 4. Approves the submission of a project nomination to the Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program Phase 4: Part B for allocation of the \$341,244 (ex GST) funding to the Township Sealing Program in Goughs Bay (\$150,000); for the construction of a gravel footpath for Monkey Gully Road (\$149,630) and for the construction of a gravel footpath on Piries-Goughs Bay Road (\$41,614).
- 5. Approves the submission of a project nomination to the Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program Phase 4: Part A for allocation of the \$591,593 (ex GST) funding to the Mt Buller Service Road Reconstruction project (\$500,000) and to the Buttercup Rd Reconstruction Project (\$91,593).
- 6. Makes this resolution public by including it within the public minutes of the Council meeting.
